### Commitment to achieving Net Zero

RemServe Medical Supplies is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050. RemServe Medical Supplies recognises the importance of preserving the environment in which we operate and is committed to establishing an environmental management policy as a priority.

### Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Scope 1 – These are all direct emissions released from the activities of an organisation. For example, fuel combustion from company vehicles.

Scope 2 – These are any indirect emissions from electricity purchased and used by the organisation. For example, the emissions from the energy consumption such as lighting in our Offices.

Scope 3 – These are any other indirect emissions from the activities of the organisation, occurring from sources that they do not own or do not control. They are usually the greatest share of the carbon footprint, covering emissions such as those associated with business travel or procurement.

### Results

- Scope 1 Direct emissions from owned or controlled assets **10.4575 tCO<sub>2</sub>e 8%**
- Scope 2 Indirect emissions from purchased electricity/Gas **6.4118 tCO<sub>2</sub>e 5%**
- Scope 3 Indirect emissions from value chain **107.8313 tCO<sub>2</sub>e 86%**

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**Baseline Year: 2023**

**Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.**

Emissions data had not been published in prior years; therefore, we selected 2022/23 as our base year. As a company with 1 Office across the UK we have not previously had a formal policy for Carbon and Climate change reporting. The methodology for measuring our carbon footprint is in line with the Greenhouse Gas protocol and the BEIS Environmental Reporting Guidelines. The calculations were completed on the Smart Carbon Calculator using the UK Government emissions factors.

## **Emissions reduction targets**

We have no previous emissions reduction commitment. To continue our process to achieve Net Zero since the base year 2023, we have adopted the following carbon reduction target:

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 107 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2028.

This is a reduction of 15%

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## **Carbon Reduction Projects**

The following environmental management projects are reviewed annually

- Overseas Supplier transport costs
- Storage and distribution opportunities to improve

## **Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives**

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline.

Solar roof panels fitted to Edwinstowe house (completed by the Woodhead Enterprises).

The Installation of LED Lighting in the Remserve Nottingham Office (completed 2024).

## **Ongoing Carbon reduction projects include**

Reduction of company business travel, commuting to be reviewed and actioned if reasonably practicable.

Reduction in plastic waste and plastic packaging materials in the fulfilment centre by using where possible:

- Recyclable cardboard packaging.
- Promote and encourage reusable drink bottle by distributing bottles and then an addition of a bulk water supply in the office.
- Company Electric van to be investigated.

## **In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:**

A transition to zero emission vehicles,

- using biodiverse Fuels/Hybrid/Hydrogen or Fully Electric powered transport.
- Further reductions in office general waste (landfill) by introducing office segregated recycling waste disposal collection points.
- Review Air Fright on purchased products from overseas.
